Thank you so much for supporting UNICEF and donating £309.87 to the East Africa Children's Crisis Appeal.

The drought is affecting more than 8 million people and endangering the lives of an estimated 1.5 million children under the age of 5. The area affected is already one of the most vulnerable regions in the world, and our number one priority now is to ensure that children are kept alive. UNICEF is already providing clean water and scaling up nutrition programmes to treat malnourished children; your donation will help us continue this work.

In February I visited Kenya to collect case studies for Day for Change, our annual fundraising and education event. The scenes are heartbreaking: women beside roads trying to coax a cow to continue walking although it has collapsed with thirst; families fetching their drinking water from muddy pools, knowing this might make their children ill, and head teachers desperately trying to make ends meet so that they can buy tanks of water for their schools. It is always hugely encouraging to know that children immediately respond to the suffering of their peers in other countries. With your help UNICEF can ensure that children in East Africa have access to water and food, and continue going to school.
